A note for grown-ups

How to get the most out of this book

Welcome

This book moves from capital letters to their small partners, then teaches the numbers 0 to 20 with something to count on every page. Rudy is back to help.

Fifteen minutes a day

One letter or number a day is a good pace. A few minutes of careful tracing is worth more than a rushed page. Keep sessions short and end on a success.

Pencil grip

Encourage the tripod grip: thumb and first finger hold the pencil, middle finger underneath. A pencil grip aid can help if fingers keep slipping. Check that the wrist rests on the table.

How the pages work

The dashed middle line is where small letters like a, c and e reach up to. Tall letters touch the top line, and letters like g and y hang below the bottom line. The start dot and numbered arrows show where to begin and which way to go.

Letter and number formation tips

Small letters that begin with a circle (a, d, g, o, q) start at the top of the circle and go round to the left. Numbers all start at the top. If a number comes out backwards, trace the model with a finger first, then try again.

**Every picture in this book is yours to colour in, so keep the crayons handy.
There is a flip book in the bottom corner of the right-hand pages. Hold the book at the spine and riffle the pages with your thumb.**
